Connecting the Trans-Canada Trail

Winter Route (November – April)

Winter Walking Loop (inset)

Crossing the old wooden rail bridge (swing bridge) is only available in winter from November to April. This connects East and West portions of the Trans Canada Trail, and allows a direct trail route across the Trent-Severn Waterway for snowmobilers, skiers, cyclists and hikers.

The rail bridge crossing also joins the winter and summer routes, which forms an enjoyable, flat 4-5 km loop trail for walking and exploring the village of Hastings.
